- LOGOWEAR: Help collect, process, sort, and distribute IMS Logowear sweatshirt and t-shirt orders. [PTSA]
- MAGAZINE DRIVE: Needed in September for 2-3 hour shifts. The fall Magazine Drive is the primary ASB fundraiser at IMS. Parent volunteers assist on magazine subscription turn-in days to reconcile magazine orders. [ASB]
- MATH OLYMPIAD: Volunteers to assist students prepare for the Math Olympiad. [IMS]
- MOST VALUABLE PANTHER: Help serve special treats one Friday each month during lunches to students who have been selected by teachers for recognition. [IMS]
- PANTHER PASSAGE: Volunteers needed to help in this program which takes place in spring 2011. 8th grade students present and share reflections of their middle school years with community members. [IMS/PTSA]
- PHONE-A-THON VOLUNTEER: Make calls as needed for various School or District-related events. [IMS/PTSA]
- REFLECTIONS: Help distribute and collect entries, organize awards and select a panel of judges. This National PTA program occurs in the fall and includes visual arts, music, photography, literature, choreography/dance, and film/video. [PTSA]
- SALMON DAYS PARKING: Volunteers are needed to work the first weekend of October. One of the most important PTSA fundraisers of the year! Many parent volunteers needed for 2-hour shifts at IMS parking lot. Free parking for the day that you work. [PTSA]
- SCHOOL BEAUTIFICATION: Help with periodic work parties to maintain school grounds and promote student participation in keeping our school beautiful. [PTSA]
- STAFF APPRECIATION WEEK: One week in May: Provide special treats to recognize our IMS staff. [PTSA]
- VISION/HEARING SCREENING: Assist Nurse with health screening. Usually 2 hours in October. [IMS]
- VOICE - Volunteers Of Issaquah Changing Education: **VOICE** volunteers work in school as one-on-one mentors with students just one hour per week. Students are referred for need of a mentor by school teachers and counselors. **VOICE** volunteers are carefully matched with the student and become positive, dependable role models and another caring adult in the life of this student. **VOICE** mentors partner with school staff to support students academically and socially. Mentors help foster social skills and motivate students' desire to be lifelong learners. One hour a week can make all the difference in the world to a struggling student. [Program is administered by the Issaquah Schools Foundation]
- WALKABOUT: Volunteers needed before/after school and during lunches as a positive presence in the hallways and common areas of the school. A training session is held once in the fall (**Tuesday, September 7, 2010 at 7:00 pm in the IMS Commons**) and is required in order for parents to participate in the program. [PTSA]
